



Situate on the south side of the west branch of Susquehanna about 3/4 of a mile east of chincliamos old town, and about one mile south west of the mouth of big Clearfield creek; including an improvement made by John Owens since the 1st of May 1803 in Clearfield County Chincliamcos township. Surveyed the 30th of October 1810 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Owens, dated the 14th of November 1807
