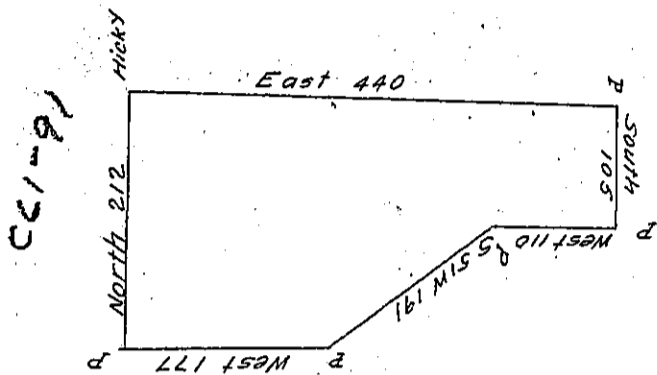

The above is the draught of a survey made April 5th 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Greffith Evans* on the 14th day of April 1792 Situate Northwest of the Ohio River on the Waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining land granted to John Oldden, called Chatigan, containing 419 Acres & 64 perches with the usual allowance of 6p Cent & C^a
