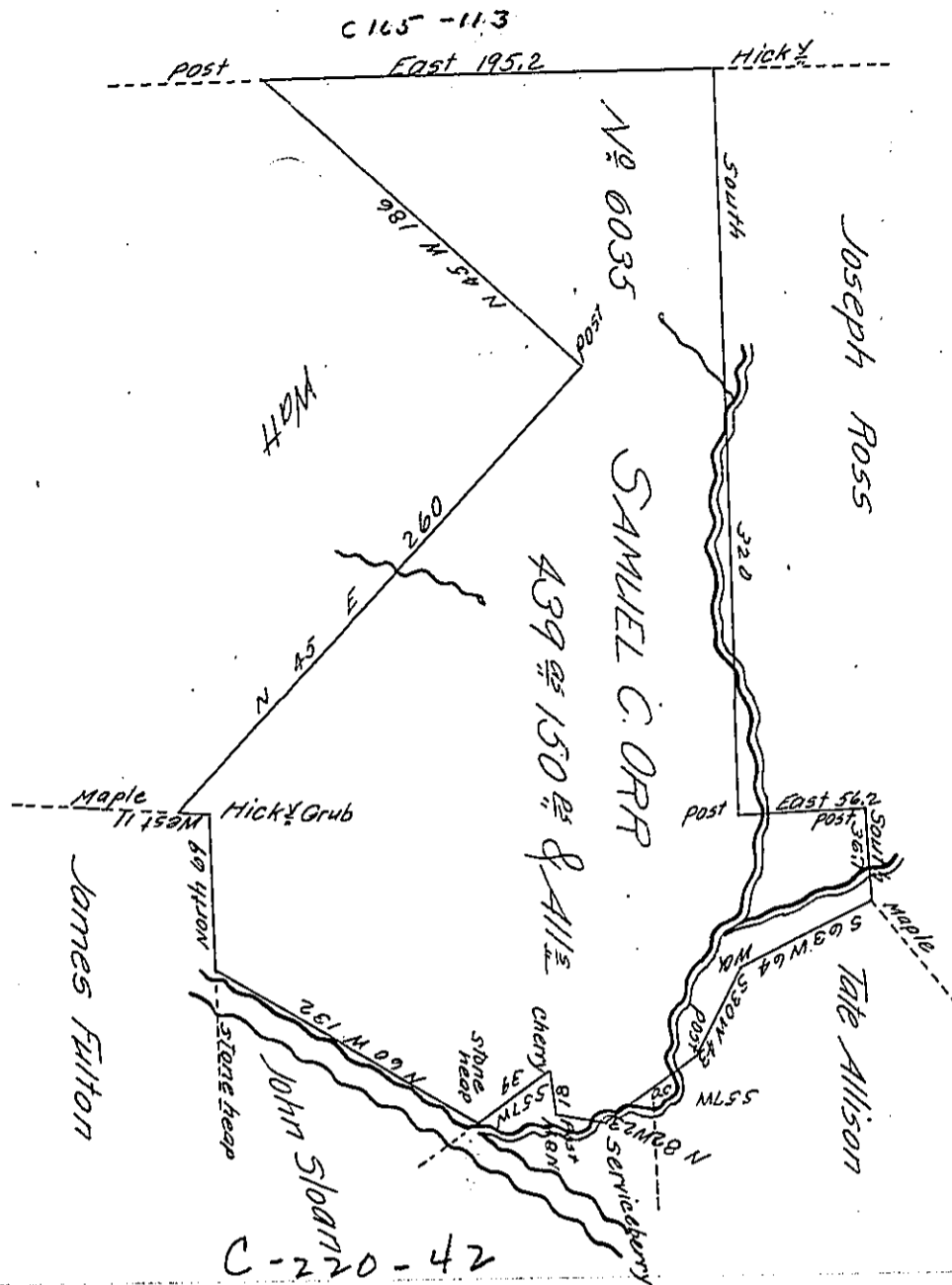


Peter Peirce

Redbank Township Armstrong County I do Certify that the within Mentioned Samuel C. Orr Actually Resides on the above described tract of land has a dwelling house and Barn thereon erected, has upwards of Forty Acres Cleared fenced and Cultivated on Said tract
