



A Draught of a Tract of land called Ringwood, Situate on the Waters of the first Brook or run that empties into Susquehanna River on the Northerly side of Mahonoy mountain, and on the path leading from ~~Mahony~~ to Sunbury, in the County of Northumberland, containing One hundred & forty nine Acres and One hundred and Nineteen perches, besides the usual allowance of six Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 10th day of June 1774, for Thomas Palmer in pursuance of an Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. Number 816, by
