



In pursuance of a Warrant dated 2<sup>d</sup> of Feby. 1784 for 300 Acres of Land Granted to Solomon Perkins, by Virtue of a Resolution of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly, to me directed was on the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of April last Surveyed and laid of three hundred and one Acres ~~& eighteen perches~~ of Land with the usual Allowance of Six Acres ~~per~~ Cent, agreeable to the above Draught situated in the Forks of Fishing Creek, in Northumberland County, adjoining Lands of Lawrence Myers & others.

Given under my hand this 4<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1784.
