Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania, bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783. the Above tract of land Containing Three hundred and four Acres and 140 Perches and Allowance of 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Cent for Roads &c, was Surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785, by
