In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of Lands therein mentioned; and ^{by} virtue of a Commission to me directed under the Hand & Seal of Office of John Lukens, Esquire, Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania, bearing dated at Philadelphia the 22^d day of August 1783, the above tract of Land Containing two hundred & sixteen Acres & one hundred and fifty six perches and Allowance of 6 ⁷/₈ Cent for Roads &c., was Surveyed on the 17th day of June 1785.
