The above is the draught of a Survey made December 7<sup>th</sup> 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Montgomery on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792. Situate Northwest of <sup>0-3-2</sup> <sup>mi</sup> <sup>0-3-2</sup> ver on the Waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining lands granted to John Mitchell, called Bryan's bridge, containing four hundred Acres with the usual allowance of 6 p. Cent &c<sup>a</sup>
