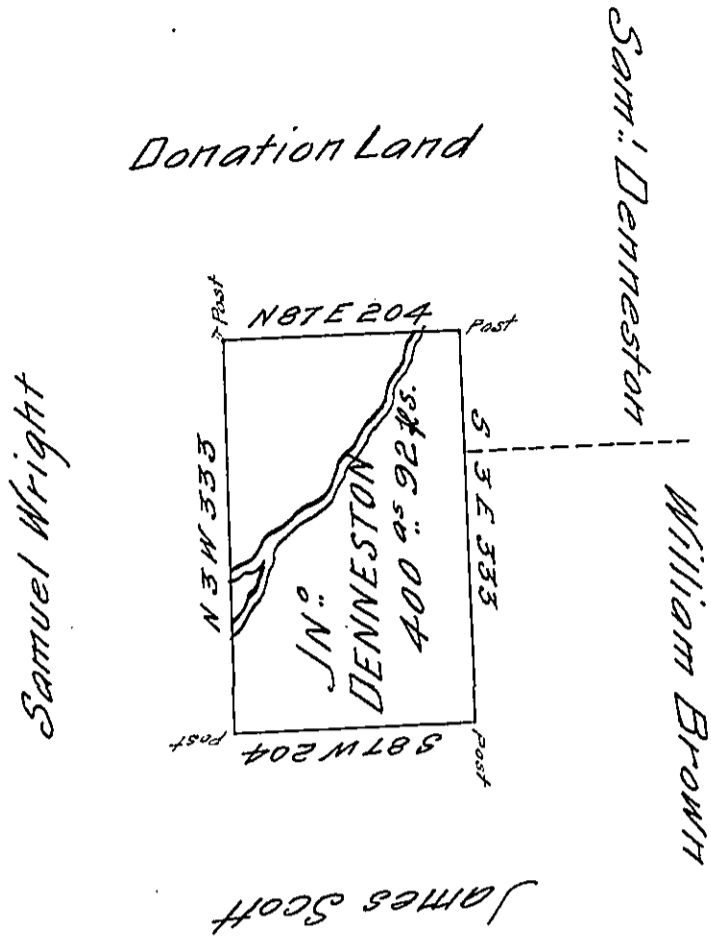


Donation Land
