

In Persuance of a Warrant for 400<sup>as</sup> granted to Isaac Fitzrandolph baring, date the 21<sup>th</sup> day of April 1794 was Resurveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1817 the above described tract of land containing 401 acres 150 perches and allowance of six per cent. for Roads &c. It being the same tract of Land which was surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of November 1794, for John Broadhead in persuance of his improvement, baring date the 3<sup>d</sup>-day of November 1794 situate in East Salem Township Mercer County Bounded North by Crawford County line and south by the south line of district N<sup>o</sup>. 2 known by W<sup>m</sup> Power's district, - and at the time of surveying the same Samuel Watt was Residing thereon and there appeared to be upwards of 12 acres Cleared, fenced &c. on the same —
