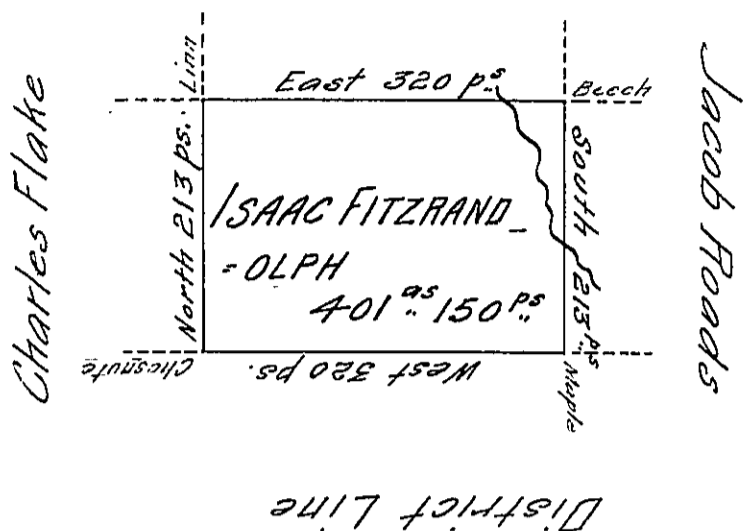

In Persuance of a Warrant for 400^{acs} granted to Isaac Fitzrandolph baring, date the 21th day of April 1794 was Resurveyed the 18th day of November, 1817 the above discribed tract of land containing 401 acres 150 perches and allowance of six per cent. for Roads &c. It being the same tract of Land which was surveyed the 3^d day of November 1794, for John Broadhead in persuance of his improvement, baring date the 3^d day of November 1794 situate in East salem Township Mercer County Bounded North by Crawford County line and south by the south line of district N^o 2 known by W^m Power's district, - and at the time of surveying the same Samuel Watt was Residing thereon and there appeared to be - upwards of 12 acres Clered, fenced &c. - on the same -
