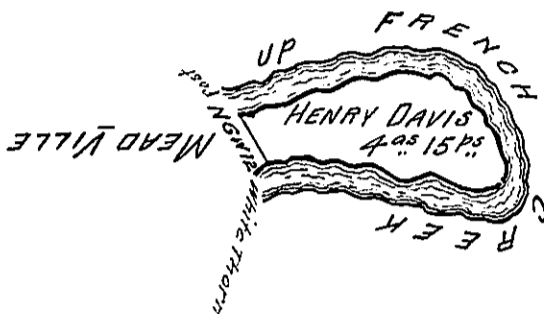


Situate on the East Side of French Creek
