



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1747 I have Survey'd to Samuel Powell a High Street Lot of Ground Appurtenant to the original Purchase of John Cole of 1000 acres of Land, Situate in the City of Philad<sup>a</sup> on the South side of High Street aforesaid, between the Fifth & Sixth Streets from Schuylkill containing in Breadth on the said High Street Twenty six feet, and in Length Three Hundred and six feet, Bounded Northward with the said High Street, Eastward with alot of Ground belonging to Samuel Powell, Minor. Southward with the Back ends of Chesnut Street Lots and Westward by the Fifth Street afs<sup>d</sup> Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> of September 1751.
