East Branch of Susquehanna—above the mouth of Tioga—in the County of Luzerne containing three hundred & four Acres & forty one perches & the allowance of Six P<sup>r</sup> Cent. Ex<sup>d</sup> & Certified by me this 16<sup>th</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup> 1803.
