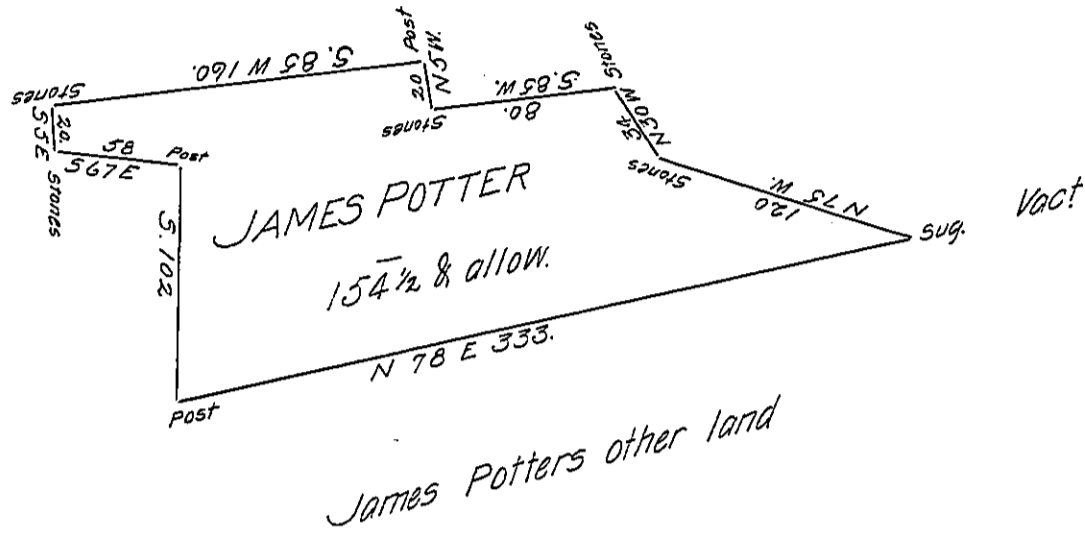

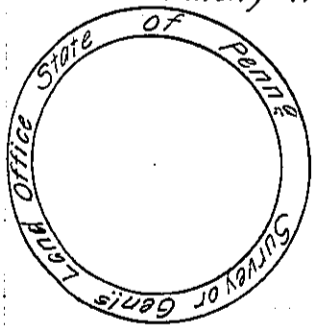


A Draught of a tract of land Called — Situate in Penns Valley & Potters Township North of
