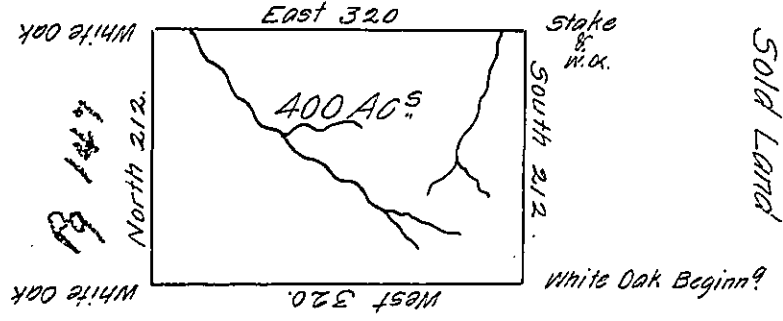

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 7<sup>th</sup> of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Henry Purviance for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio On the Waters of Conaquesing Creek Adjoini<sup>g</sup> Land Granted to Robert Purviance Called Dolgelly Containing four Hundred Acres together with the Usual Allowance of Six P<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Roads.
