



Situate formerly in Newbury, but now in Fairview Township in the County of York, late part of the County of Lancaster. Containing as above set forth 24 1/2 & 17 Perches and allowance of Six Per Cent & C. Being part of a larger Tract of 793 1/2 & allowance of Land, which was Originally Surveyed by Thomas Cookson late D.S. on the 18th day of March A.D. 1747. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 500^a Granted to William Passmore bearing date the 1st day of December A.D. 1743. Resurveyed the above and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 14th day of May A.D. 1811. at the request of the owner John Singer who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
