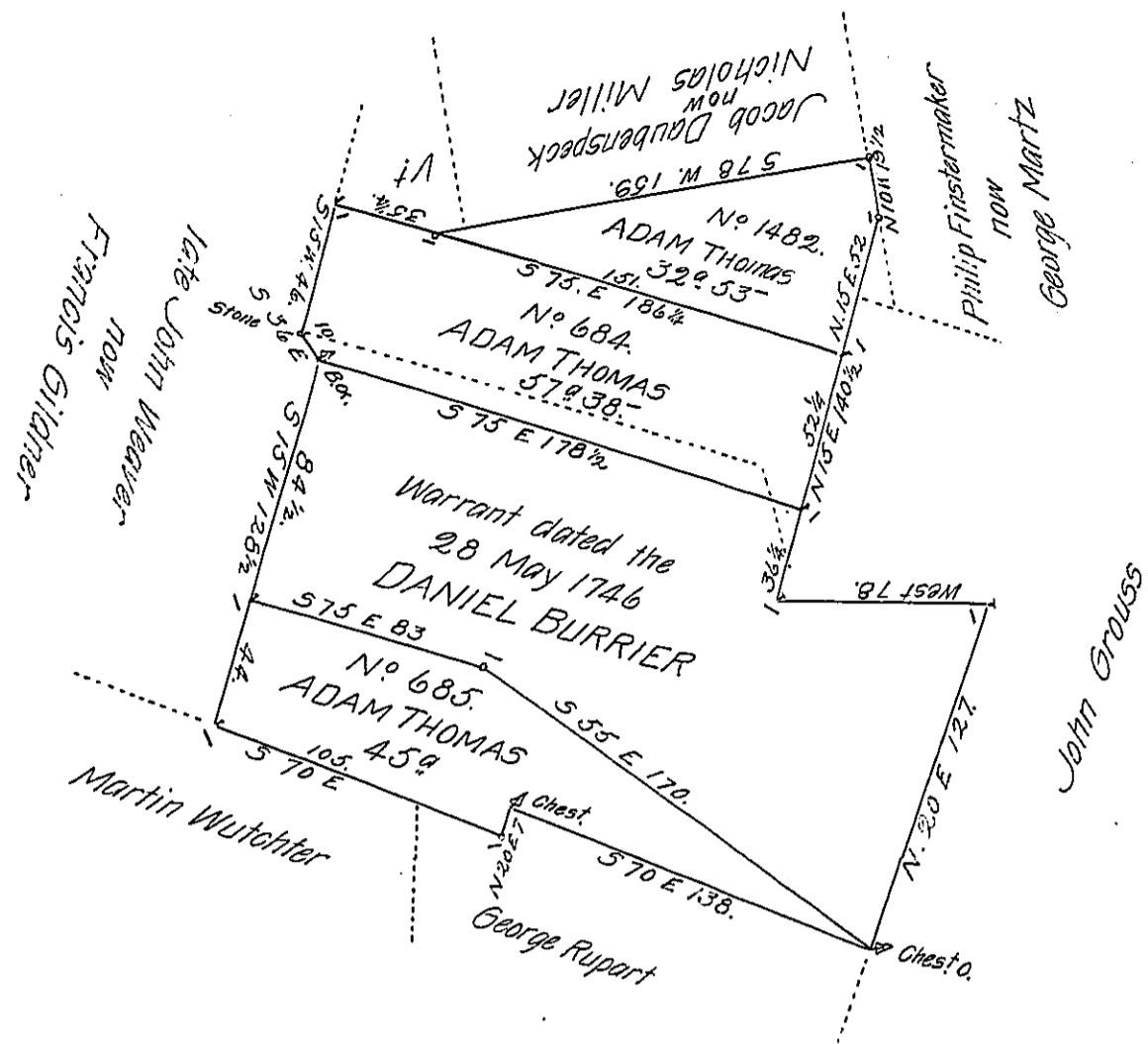

Sir. Moor township the 6 May 1811.
 On the 2^d July 1783 John Peter applied to me to Resurvey his land laid down in the annexed draft consisting of four tracts he then told me the tract N^o 1482 and N^o 685 were Returned in the Surveyor Generals Office by James Scull the late Deputy Surveyor that the tract N^o 684 and the Warrant land Daniel Burrier must be Returned which two tracts I returned.

Patents issued the 9 April 1810. one Patent for the two tracts Surveyed to Adam Thomas viz N^o 684 & N^o 1482. for 89 Acres & 91 perches agreeable to the annexed draft. a Patent also issued the 28th April 1810 for Daniel Burriers tract agreeable to the annexed draft.

I now find that M^r Scull had also returned the tract N^o 684 Some what differently to wit 51 3/4^{ac} which was also Patented the 9 April 1810 & that Patents calls for N^o 685 altho I believe the Return of Sculls is N^o 684. Therefore the tract N^o 685 to Adam Thomas of 45 Acres is not Returned at all. I have now sent that return & if a Patent can be granted for that tract & the owners of the Patent of 51 Acres & three quarters ^{by} Relinquishing the same all would then be right.

The dotted lines in N^o 684 & in Dan^l Burriers tract represent N^o 684 as Scull returned it, As I could not obtain any of M^r Sculls General drafts during the life time of his Widow it was impossible for me to know how he had divided the land between Thomas and Burrier and as both those tracts belonged to John Peter at the time I Surveyed it I thought it was not of importance.
