



Situate on the waters of Redstone Creek in Union Township Fayette County and is part of a tract of Land Surveyed for Robert Hamilton the Last day of September 1769 by order of Survey N^o 806 dated the 3^d day of April 1769 And by him transfer'd to Joseph Waller and by Joseph Waller to Alexander Crawford and by him to John Kidd and by John Kidd to Jonathan Hill and afterwards seiz'd and taken in Execution by the Sheriff of Fayette County in satisfaction of the debts of the said Jonathan Hill and sold by the said Sherriff to Joseph Atkinson. (the residue is patented)
