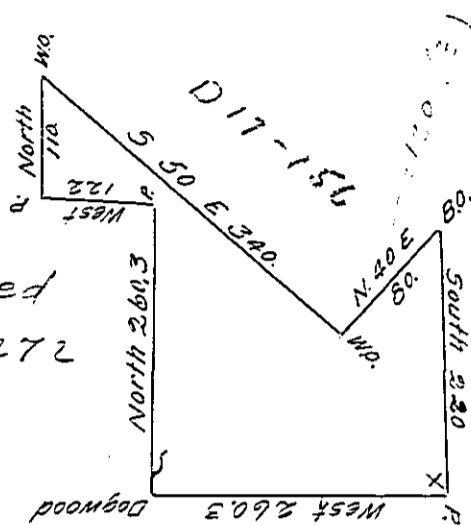

The Above is the draught of a Survey made March 25<sup>th</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Pleasants on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 Situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the Waters of Little Beaver Creek Adjoining land granted to John Phillips, Called Dancaba, containing 437 Acres and 32 perches with the usual allowance of 6 P. Carr & C.
