In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Richard Peters Esquire bearing date the thirtieth day of October A.D. 1753. The above part Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract on the 6th day of December A.D. 1811 at the request of the present owner David Warren, who has now desired the same to be returned for Confirmation the 10th day of January 1814.
