



A Draught of one hundred and sixty four acres and forty six perches of land with six per Cent for roads ~~and~~ &c. situated in Lack township in Mifflin county Surveyed 10th. March 1810 in pursuance of a Warrant to James Pollock dated Lancaster 1st. June 1809.

Appears to contain eight acres, which appears to have been cleared and fenced and much cultivated long since but which appears now to be abandoned; time and fire have destroyed dwelling house and fences, for the improvement appears to be very old.

Represents an Improvement in draught of more than half an acre of land cleared and under fence; and a very small cabin
