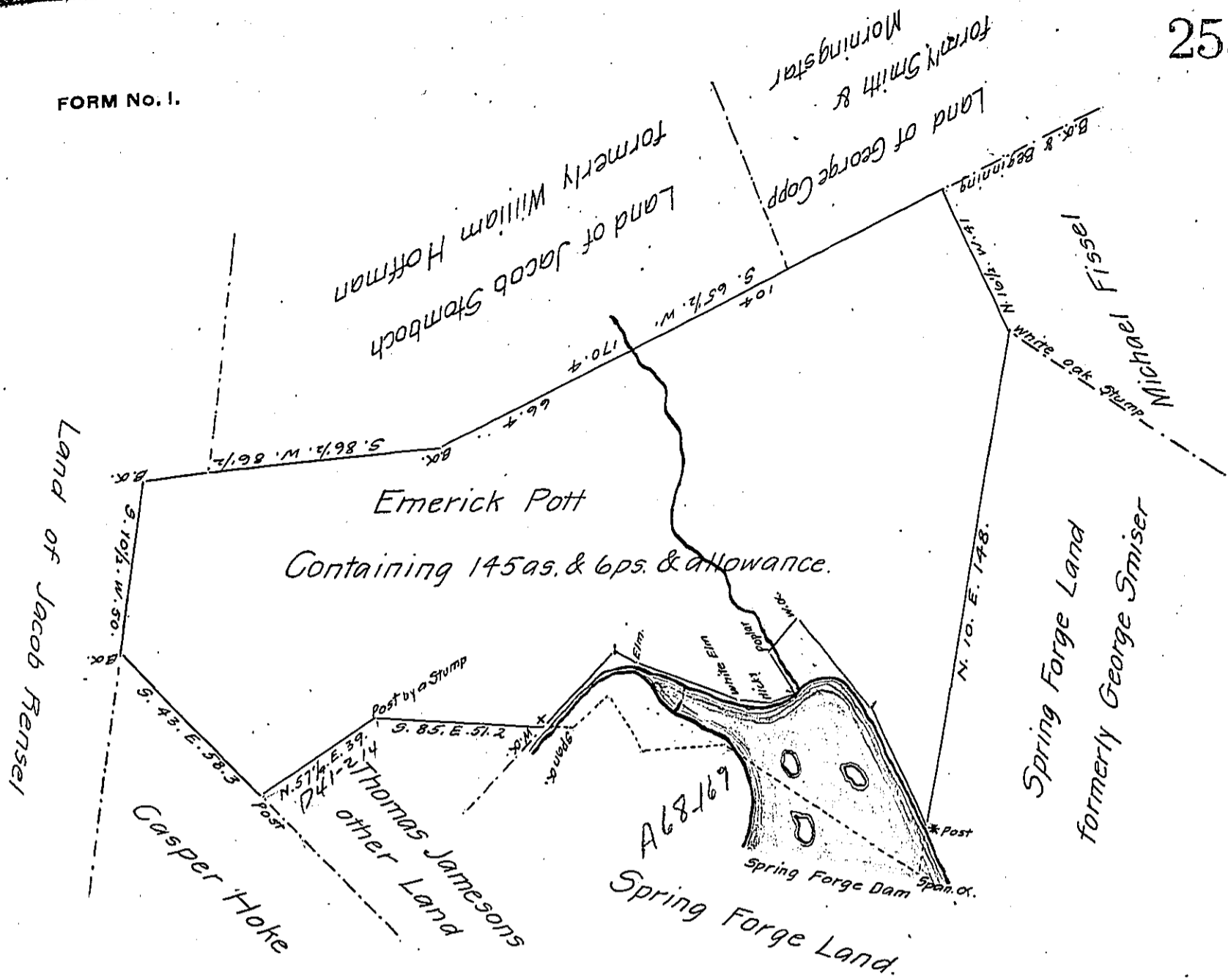

Granted to Emerick Pott bearing date the 1st day of August 1744 And now Resurveyed and divided off from the Said Larger tract of Land on the 26th day of February A.D. 1813 at the request of Dr. Thomas Jameson who desired the Same to be Returned for Confirmation.
