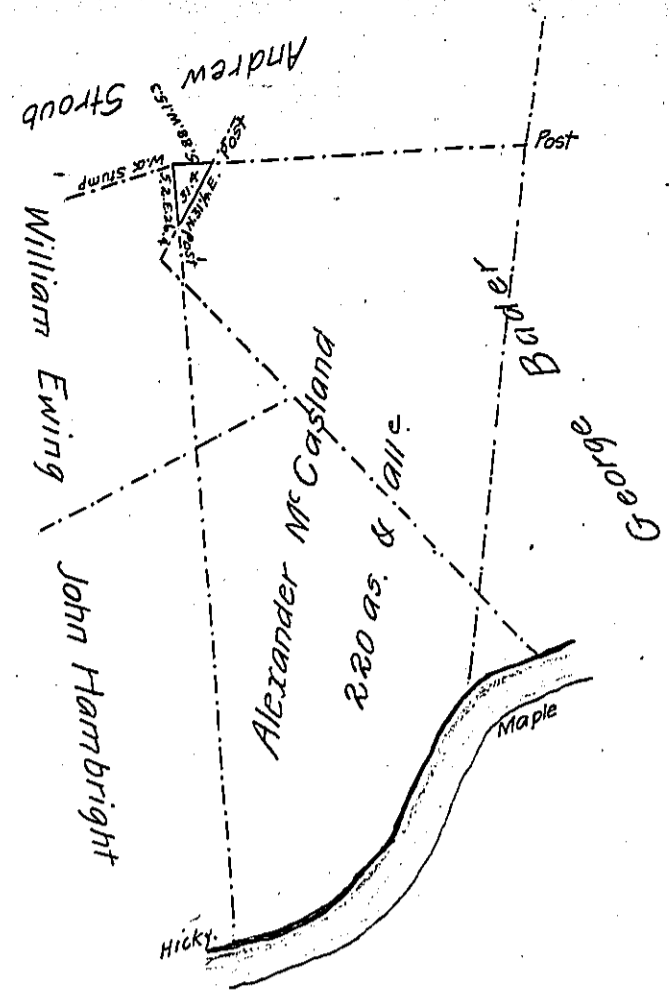

One thousand seven hundred and ~~and~~ sixty eight, Number 4720.
