



We the undersigned two of the Commissioners of the County of Northampton constituted a board of Appraisers for the purpose mentioned in Act of the General Assembly passed the 10th day of April 1835 entitled an Act to Graduate Lands in which money is due and unpaid to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania having been duly sworn according to the directions of the said Act do Certify that at the desire of Samuel Ott the owner of the land above mentioned and described. We went upon & viewed the ground and appraised the said land for its cash value (the value of the Buildings thereon erected being deducted) at Three dollars and fifty Cents pr. acre and have rated the same No. 4. Witness our hands & Seals this 16th day of January A.D. 1838
