



A Draught of a Piece of Land, Situate in Codorus township in the County of York, Containing 67 as & 2 perches and allowance &c. part of 69 as & allowance &c. which was originally surveyed on the 12th day of the 10th month 1774, by William Mathews, late D.S. In pursuance of a warrant for 50 as granted to John Ott, bearing date the 15th day of June 1774. Since Resurveyed & divided &c. Now on the 29 day of february A.D. 1841, Examined & Corrected the above &c. at the request of David Meckly, the present owner, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation.
