



The above described tract of land was surveyed to Alexander Osburn on the 27 day of June 1842 containing thirty acres and fifty six perches and allowance of six per cent &c. Situate in Monroe Township Clarion County being a part of a larger Survey that was made on the 6th day of May 1840 in pursuance of a Warrant dated 8th April 1840 granted to the said Alexander Osburn containing in all one hundred and four acres and one hundred and twenty seven perches and allowance &c. As appears from a Survey on file in the Deputy Surveyors Office of Clarion County that part included in the plotted lines is held by an earlier Warrant and Survey to Jonathan Frampton
