



Situate in the township & County of Huntingdon about a mile above the town of Huntingdon on the opposite ^{side} of the River originally surveyed by Richard Tea on the 4th day of September 1766 in pursuance of an order No 770 for one hundred acres dated the 4th day of August 1766 and resurveyed & some errors corrected on the 10th day of July 1793 and now contains one hundred and two acres twenty one perches and the usual allowance for roads
