



A draught of part of the Lottery Land situate in the Haycock Town-ship in Bucks County containing 146 acres & 152 perches & an allowance of six P Ct surveyed for Barbary Rhor the 16th day of ^{MAY} 1774 pursuant to an order dated the 20th day of April then last past

To John Lukens Esq S.G. P: Tho Shapman --

A considerable part of the above land is of a thin soil too wet for plough land and too dry in summer for meadow tho very good for pasture the remainder is a strong good soil but very stoney I think in the whole it is not quiet as good as George Amey's tho better than Christian Gayman's
