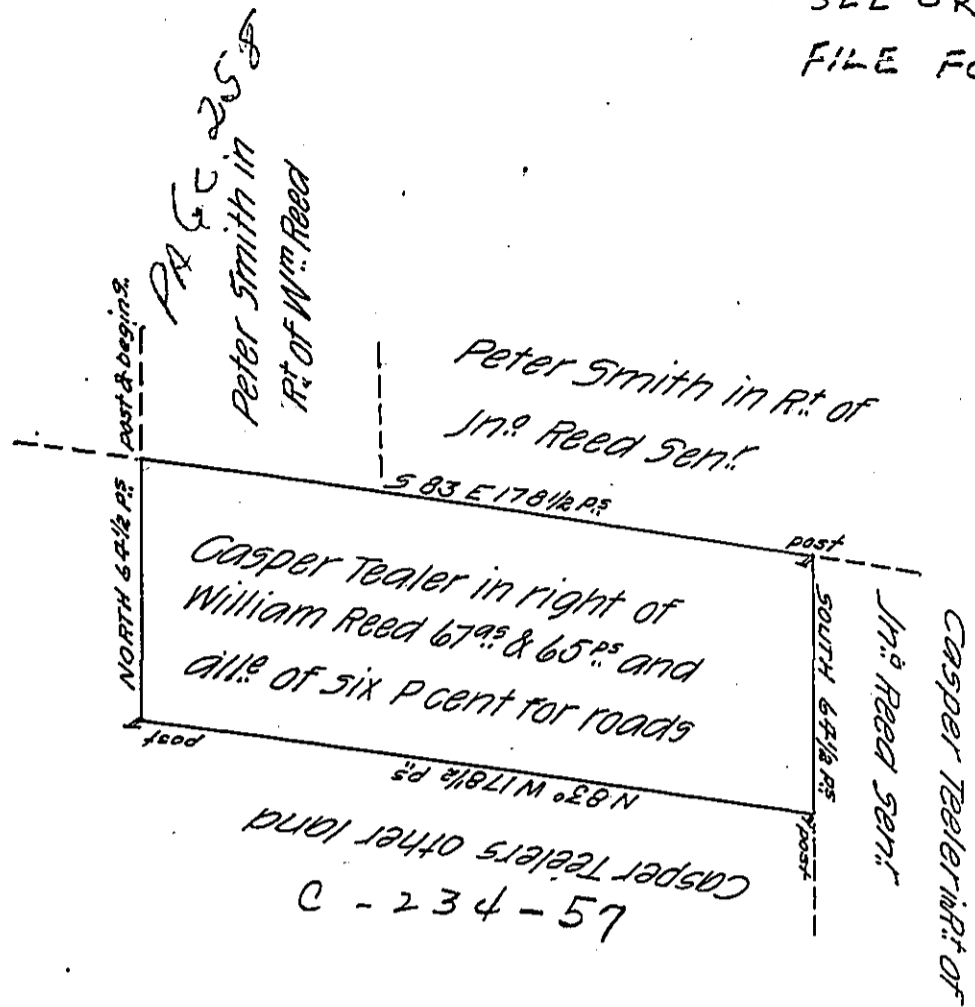

A draught of a tract of land situate in Middleton township in Cumberland County containing sixty seven acres and sixty five perches and allowance of six P cent for roads (being a moiety or half part of a tract of three hundred and thirty four acres and eighty perches and allowance as aforesaid surveyed for William Reed in pursuance of a warrant granted him by the Honourable the Proprietaries bearing date the second day of July Anno Domini 1762) surveyed and divided off from the said large tract for Casper Teeler
