



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the tenth day of September 1734 survey to Michael Rider a tract of land situate in Newcowisschopin - in the County of Philad^a beginning at a corner stone in a line of Thomas Hammonda's thence by the same Northwest seventy five perches and vacant land fifty perches to a post thence by Vact Land North East two hundred & four perches to a white oak in the County Line thence by the same South East one hundred twenty five perches to a corner stone thence by Vact Land South West two hundred and four perches to the place of beginning containing one hundred and fifty acres with the usual allowance of six P cent surveyed Nov^r 1st 1734
