 a Warrant for 200<sup>a</sup> granted to Andrew Noel Dated

 26<sup>th</sup> March 1793

a copy of the above Draught I examined & sent to  
 your Office about the first of November 1805 in  
 which the Township is called Franklin instead of  
 Manallen the Township is called Franklin in the  
 survey book as recorded by M<sup>c</sup>Clean but the land  
 does not lay within 5 miles of Franklin Township  
 Conococheague creek runs through it no part of such  
 branch rises in Franklin Township Certified the 5<sup>d</sup>  
 December 1805
