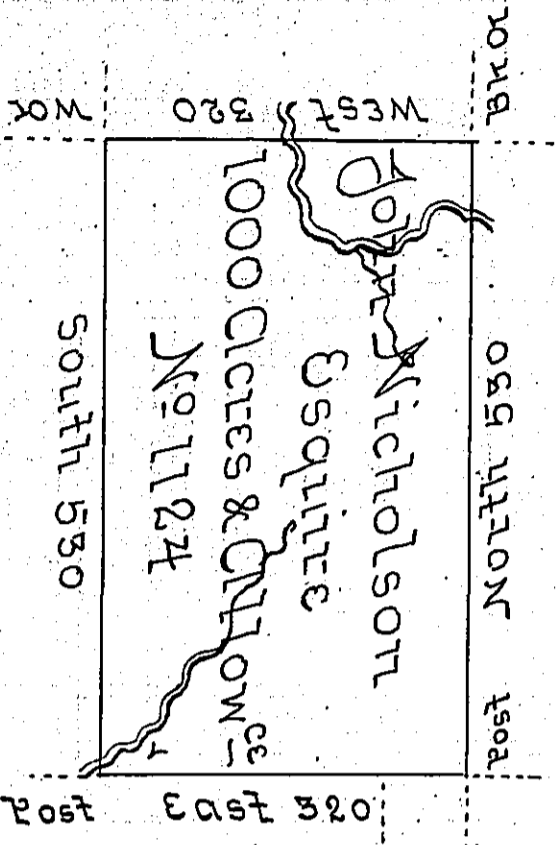

Surveyed on the fifth day of July 1793 One thousand Acres of Land with the allowance of six per Cent Situate in District No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Alleghany River about Nine Miles East of the point opposite the Mouth of French Creek on a branch of a Run emptying into the Alleghany River about a Mile and a half below said point, by virtue of a Warrant to John Nicholson Esquire No 1124 dated the Twentieth day of April 1792.
