



The above is a draught of a survey made the 31st of January 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Francis Nichols for 400 acres of land dated the 4th of January 1794 situate North and West of the River Ohio on Slippery Rock Creek adjoining land granted to William Nichols called Randle containing four hundred acres and allowance of six per cent for roads
