Branch of Susquehanna about 3/4 of a mile above the mouth of Fishing Creek, near the partition line of Berks & Northampton Counties, containing Two hundred and ninety eight acres & three Quarters, and the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed June 3^d 1769 for Francis Stewart. In pursuance of an Order No. 34. dated April 3^d 1769.
