



In pursuance of an Order from the Commission of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772, a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for Thomas Alexander on a certain Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Sunbury, in the County of Northumb<sup>r</sup>. marked in a General plan of said Town Number fourteen, containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of the Square Sixty feet, and length North and South One hundred and seventy feet, Bordered Southward by the Square, Eastward by Lot number fifteen, Northward by Mulberry Alley and Westward by Center Alley. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1775, for Samuel M. Neal
