



Situate near Spruce-(Originally called the North Branch of Junata-) in Franklin Township Huntingdon County Containing Three Hundred and Forty one Acres one hundred & fifty four perches and the usual Allowance. First Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Dec<sup>r</sup>. 1793. and resurveyed agreeably to the original lines found on the ground the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 1838. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to William McIlheny dated Oct. 25<sup>th</sup> 1784.
