Also being part of lot Number five in the third tier of lots in said Town<sup>sh</sup> for<sup>no</sup> which no certificate issued under the act of 4<sup>th</sup> of April 1799 and its Supplements thereto. The original Survey of Thomas Paschall contains 431<sup>95</sup> 147 P<sup>s</sup> & all Resurveyed the above described land to the said Thomas Paschall on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1825.
