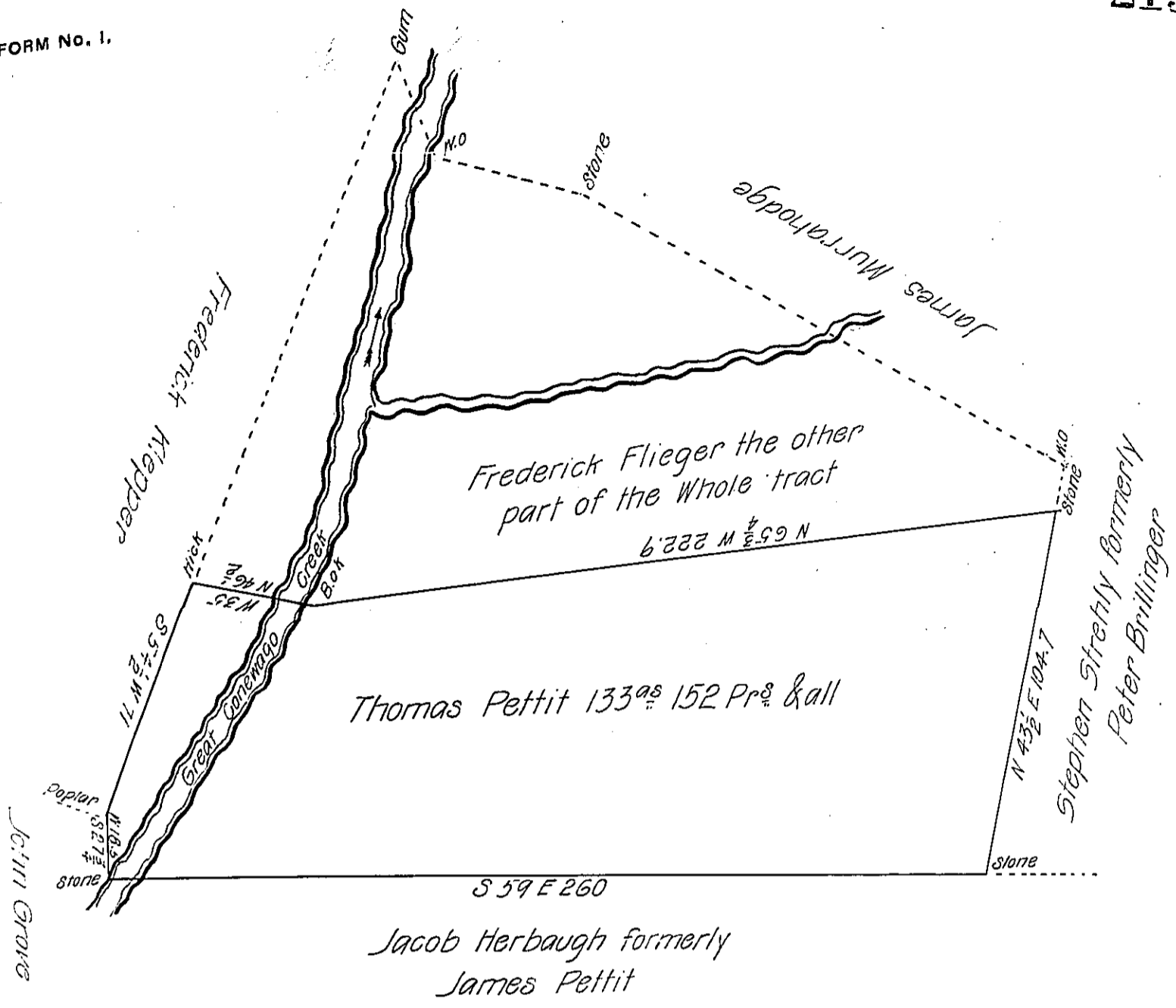


FORM No. 1.



Situate in Dover & Washington townships York County. Containing One hundred and thirty three acres one hundred and fifty two perches & allowance of six per cent part of 211<sup>as</sup> & allowance. Surveyed by George Stevenson then D.S on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of January 1751 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Pettit dated the 8<sup>th</sup> of December 1750. Divided 22<sup>nd</sup> January 1823 for Nicholas Zinn owner of said part.
