Surveyed the 26th day of December 1793 pursuant to a Warrant granted to Christian Bechtel (or Pachtel) the 13th day of May 1793 as appears by said Warrant directed to Joseph J. Wallis then Deputy Surveyor and also by said Survey (not signed) remaining filed in my office, dated as above, the lines on the ground examined by me the 14th day of January Anno Domini 1828
