



A Draught of a Tract of land situate in Warring Township in the County of York, Containing one hundred and eighty three acres and an half and the allowance of six acres per Cent for Roads & Highways. Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1749 by Thomas Cookson Esqr. late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County in pursuance of a warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August 1749.
