A draught of a tract of land situate on the Waters of Lycamaking Creek about twenty one miles north of the old purchase line in the County of Northumberland within the last Purchase made of the Indians. Containing one thousand and sixty acres and one hundred and forty three perches with the usual allowance of six P^{er} Cent for Roads &c? Surveyed for Timothy Pickering Samuel Hodgdon Duncan Ingraham Junr and Tench Coxe the 4th day of June 1786 In Pursuance of a Warrant dated May 17th 1785. No 469.
