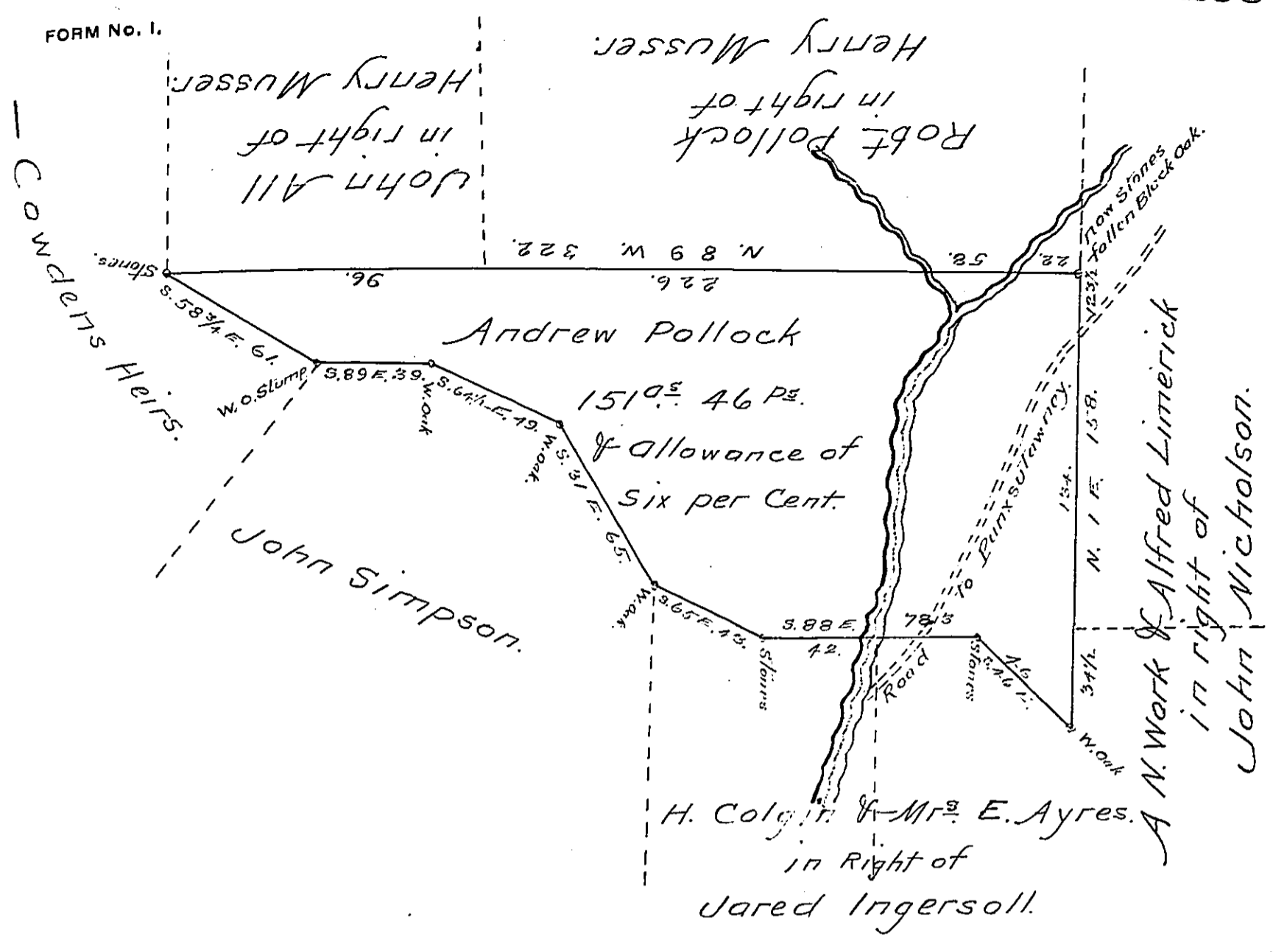


FORM No. 1.



Surveyed to Andrew Pollock February 18th 1851 the above described tract of land situated in East Mahoning Township Indiana County containing One hundred and fifty one acres and forty six perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. In pursuance of a Warrent dated 17th day of January A.D. 1851 Granted to the said Andrew Pollock. This land has about sixty acres cleared and under fence a Cabbin house and Cabbin Barn thereon settled by Johnathan Canaan about the year A. D. 1824.
