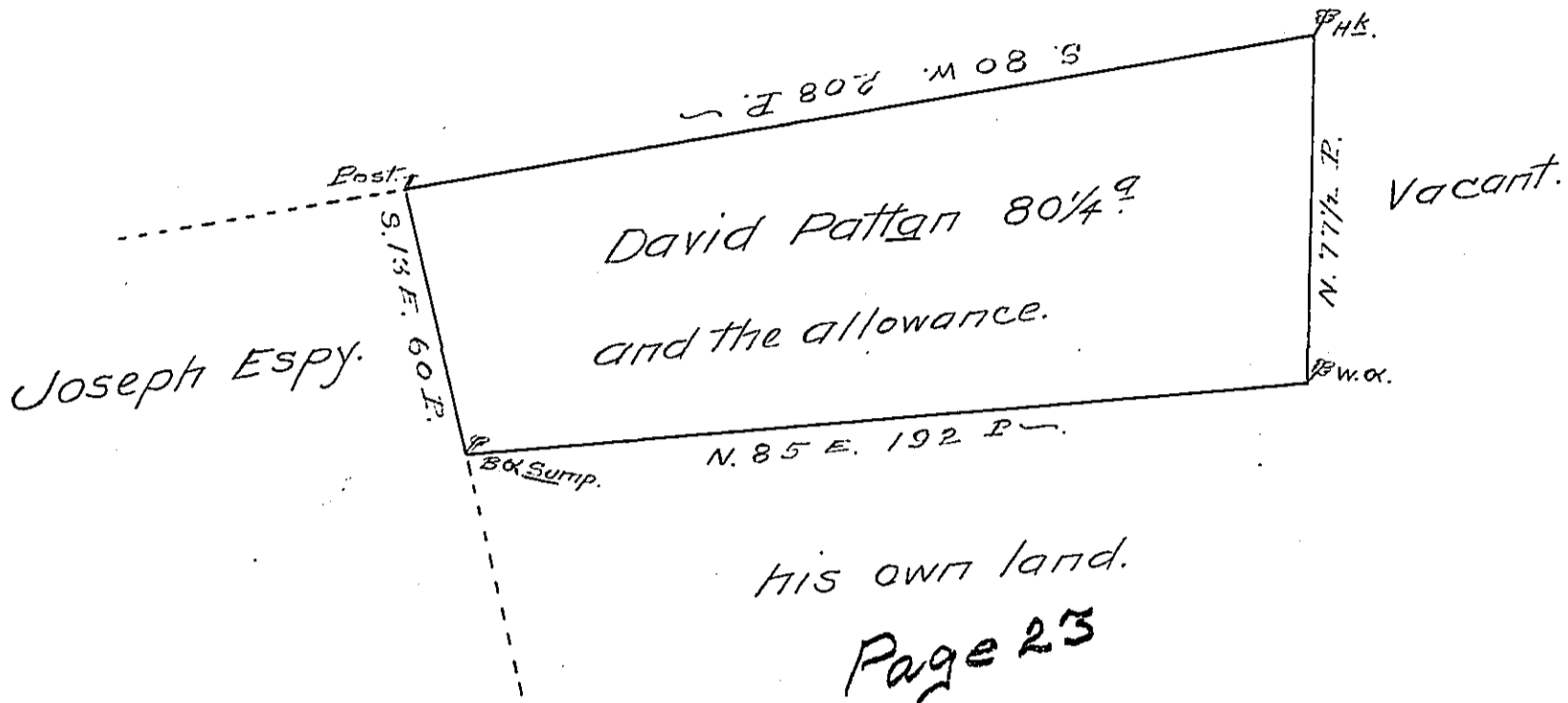


Blue Mountain.
