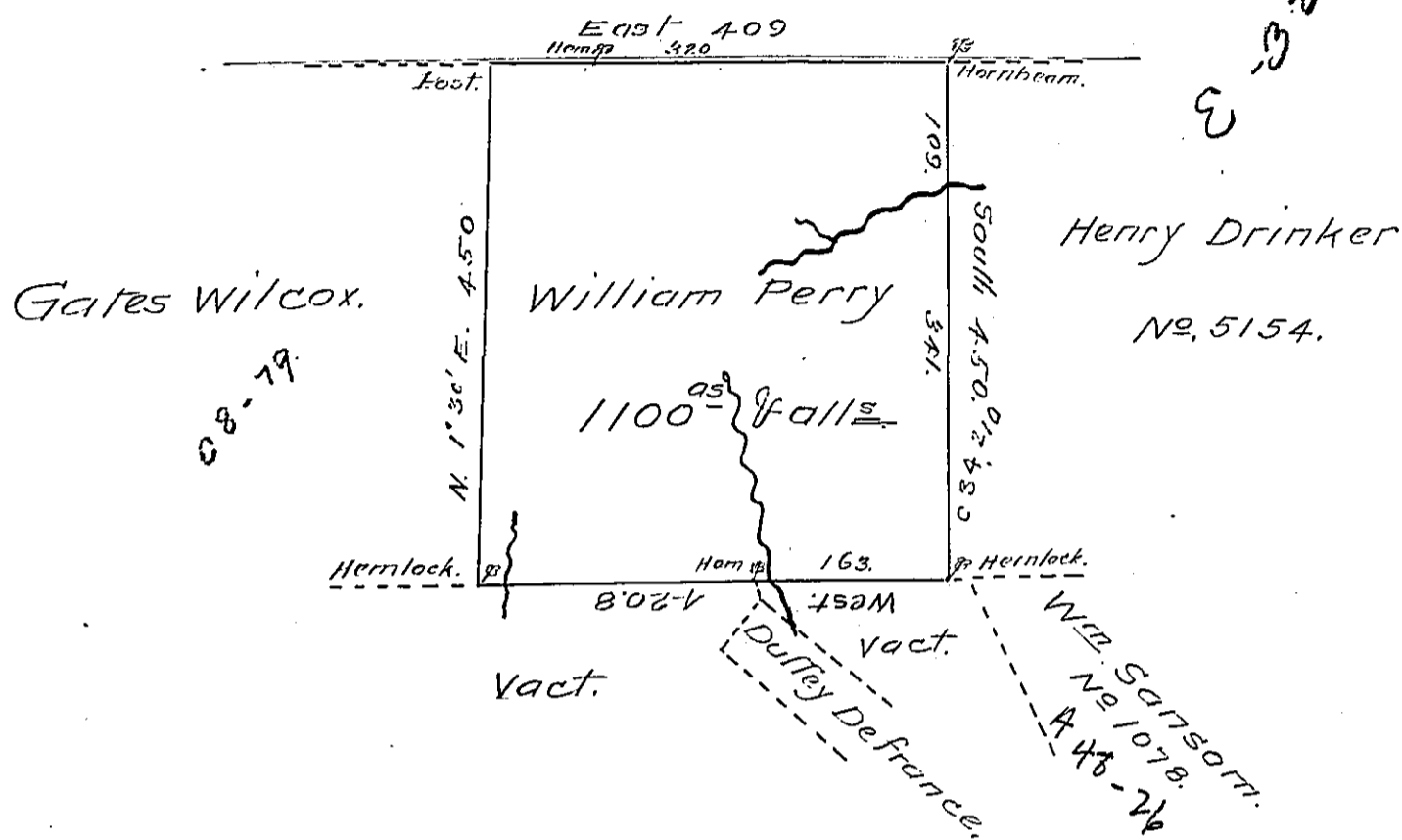


Potter County.
