



By VIRTUE of a warrant granted to Jacob Poh bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 1793 for a tract of Land situate in Albany Township Berks County. A ~~return of~~ survey was made on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1859 and returned to the Surveyor General's Office for Michael Hendrix and George Bolich in whom no title is vested and as the survey is not correct because it interfered with a survey made the 24<sup>th</sup> day of July 1794 on warrant granted to Thomas Earl dated Nov. 18<sup>th</sup> 1793. An order from the Board of Property dated Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> 1862 was granted to David Heinly and to me directed requesting me to execute the same and make return thereof to the Surveyor General's Office. A resurvey made the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January 1863 for David Heinly in right of Jacob Poh and the above described tract contains 32<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 158 perches and the allowance of six per cent.
