The part marked C. ^{Containing 582.124 perches & allowance} being a tract of land granted to David Sidwell in right of Andrew Patent by warrant dated the 8th day of November 1750. Resurveyed the above tracts of land on the 8th day of February 1864 for David Fishel the present owner who wishes to obtain a Patent for the same.
