Surveyed and laid off from a larger Tract of Land for Richard Harris - which said larger Tract was surveyed the 18th day of March 1747 by Thos. Cookson late D.S. In pursuance of a warrant granted to William Passmore dated the 1st. day of December 1743 - The above now resurveyed for George Harris (son of said Richard) 31st. May 1809.
