George Stevenson late D.S. and the old lines are now exactly followed (Except the taking in a small Vacancy as above represented.

And now at the request of the above named Henry Shank, we are desired to make return of the Draught as Calculated, examined and found to be Correct the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1803
