



IN PURSUANCE of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Thirty Eight, Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Mulberry Alley sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number One Hundred and Thirty Seven Southward by Mulberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and thirty Nine. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 22^d day of February 1775 for George Palmer —
